



THE COLLEGE OF JUSTICE COURT JUDGES

In the fall of 2006, the **Texas Justice Court Judges Association (JCJ)** formed a new society for Texas justices of the peace who desire advanced education and who should be recognized for that endeavor.

This society is known as the **College of Justice Court Judges** and will recognize those justices of the peace who receive at least (10) hours of accredited education each year above the mandatory certification requirements.

We've had an overwhelming response to the College and expect over 75 judges to have completed the requirements for charter membership in the College this year. They will be recognized this fall with an induction banquet as a charter member of the College.

Membership in the College requires an application with JCJ each year and we will be sending out applications to all of the Texas justice courts judges within the next few days for the 2007-2008 education year. You may also download the application from our website soon.
